PRIOR TO INSTALLATION:

- 1. Factory service manual is recommended to have on hand.
- 2. Secure and properly block vehicle prior to beginning installation.
- 3. Always wear safetly glasses when using power tools or working under the vehicle
- 4 Modification to any part will void the warranty associated with that product

AFTER REMOVING PARTS FROM VEHICLE, SAVE HARDWARE FOR REINSTALLATION

Step 1 Jack up the front of the vehicle and support under the frame rails with jack stands.









Step 2 Unbolt all 4 bolts holding the forward most skid plate on and remove the skid plate.

Step 2 Place ann adjustable jack under the front differential and remove the two front mounting bolts.



Step 3 For models with a stamped steel support, bend down the lip of the sub frame support to make way for the diff in its new lower position.

Step 5 Some secondary skid plates will have a tab that will need to be bent to clear the diff mount. If yours has this tab, bent it out of the way now.









Step 4 If your truck is equipped with a secondary skid plate directly below the differential, then remove the front two mounting bolts and for:


Tacoma: Install the 1/2" tall aluminum spacers along with the provided M8-1.25 x 30 bolts and washers.

4runner: Install the 1/8" thick gold washers along with the provided M8-1.25 x 30 bolts and washers.



Step 6 Lower the jack down and install the provided 1" tall spacers between the diff mounting bracket and the cross member. Re-use the factory cup shaped washer at the bottom along with the provided 9/16" bolt and the provided 9/16" washer and nut at the top.

NOTE: IF THE NYLOCK DOES NOT CONTACT THE THREADS, **OMIT THE WASHER.**





Step 7 Once the diff is tight, re-install the factory skid plate. You will use the provided M8-1.25 x 40 bolts along with the 3/4" tall spacers to attach the skid plate near the diff and the factory bolts at the front. NOTE: FOR **4RUNNERS, THE FRONT HOLES OF THE SKID PLATE WILL** NEED TO BE DRILLED OUT WITH A1/2" DRILL BIT.
